

ORDINANCE NO. 69-1

AN ORDINANCE TO LICENSE AND  
REGULATE REAL ESTATE BROKERS.

BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF  
TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. License Required.

It shall be unlawful for any to act as a real estate  
broker in the Village of Chatham without obtaining a license to do so.

SECTION 2. Application For License.

Every person who desires to obtain a license to act as a  
Real Estate Broker shall make application with the Village Clerk in  
writing. The applicant must be a citizen of the United States and duly  
licensed by the State Department of Registration and Education.

SECTION 3. Refusal, Revocation or Suspension.

A license or renewal thereof may be refused or, if it has  
been granted, may be suspended or revoked by the President or Board  
of Trustees for the violation of or for any of the causes set forth in  
Illinois Revised Statutes, Chapter 114 1/2, Section 8., as grounds for  
refusal, suspension or revocation of a license by the State Department  
of Registration and Education.

SECTION 4. Expiration of license.

The expiration date of any license granted by the Village  
Clerk shall expire as of December 31st of the year in which same has  
been granted.

SECTION 5. License Fee.

Each applicant for a license shall pay to the Village Clerk  
the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) at the time of the application for said  
license.

SECTION 6. Effective Date : Publication.


This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after its passage and publication according to law. The Village Clerk is hereby authorized to make this Ordinance available for public use by duplicating copies hereof.
