

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CONTRACT

BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and Trustees of the Village of Chatham,

Sec. 1. That the Village enter a contract for tele-metering service for its water system with General Telephone Company in accordance with the contract attached hereto, marked Exhibit A, and made a part hereof, and that said contract be executed on behalf of the Village by the President of the Board of Trustees and the Village Clerk.

Sec. 2. This ordinance shall take effect within the minimum time provided by law from and after its passage, signing and recordation.

TELEMETERING SERVICE CONTRACT

This Agreement between the VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, an Illinois municipal corporation, hereinafter called Village, and GENERAL TELEPHONE COMPANY, hereinafter called Company, WITNESS:

Sec. 1. The Company agrees to furnish and install facilities for telemetering service for the pumping station and elevated storage tank owned by the Village of Chatham, encompassing a circuit of approximately 3-1/2 miles, commencing at the storage tank located near U.S. Route 66 and ending at the elevated storage tank in the Village of Chatham.

Sec. 2. The Village agrees to pay an installation charge of \$34.00 and a monthly service charge of \$17.50 for this service, subject to changes of General Telephone Company's filed tariff.

Sec. 3. This contract is subject to termination upon six (6) months notice.

Sec. 4. The Village agrees to pay the charges for the said installation of service as billed.
