EXHIBIT "C"

ORDINANCE NUMBER 77-14

AN ORDINANCE PROHITIBING THE CONNECTION OF SANITARY OR INDUSTRIAL WASTE SEWERS TO STORM WATER DRAINAGE SYSTEMS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS:

Section I. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to connect or cause to be connected, any drain carrying, or to carry, any toilet, sink, basement, septic tank, cesspool, industrial water, or any fixture or device discharging polluting substances, to any storm water drain in the Village of Chatham.

Section II. Any person, firm or corporation violating this ordinance shall be fined not less than FIFTY

Dollars, nor more than Two HUNDARD & FIFTY Dollars for each offense, and a separate offense shall be deemed committed for each and every day during which violation containeds or exists.
