

ORDINANCE NO. 78-2

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO.  
75-10 RELATING TO REGULATIONS AND FEES  
FOR THE INSTALLATION OF ELECTRICAL SERVICE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES  
OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 75-10 shall be amended  
as follows:

"Section 3. Extension of service charge to  
single-family residences, commercial or business  
establishments or trailer or mobile home parks.)  
Any person, firm or corporation applying for the  
extension of the village distribution system to  
provide electric service to a single-family dwell-  
ing, commercial or business establishment, or  
trailer or mobile home shall not be granted such  
service by the village unless and until such  
applicant shall pay to the village the following  
fee plus actual cost of wire and equipment required:

(3) (a) RESIDENTIAL OVERHEAD SERVICE

Service	Fee plus cost
100 Ampere	\$60.00 plus actual cost of wire
200 Ampere	\$75.00 plus actual cost of wire
over 200 Ampere	\$75.00 plus actual cost of wire plus difference in actual cost of service over 200 Amp. service

Service will be installed from masthead on structure to dis-  
tribution line by Village.

(3) (b) RESIDENTIAL UNDERGROUND SERVICE

Service	Fee
100 Ampere	\$60.00
200 Ampere	\$75.00
Over 200 Ampere	\$75.00 plus actual dif- ference in cost of service over such actual cost for 200 Ampere service

Service will be installed from meter base to distribution line by customer or property owner. The maintenance of underground service from the meter base to distribution line is the responsibility of the customer or property owner.

(3) (c) TRAILER OR MOBILE HOME PARK SERVICE

Service	Fee
Per lot	\$50.00

Owner is to furnish and install 200 ampere meter pedestal at location designated by village.

(3) (d) COMMERCIAL, GOVERNMENTAL OR BUSINESS SERVICE

Customer will pay estimated cost of labor, material, use of equipment and labor overhead. Village will install overhead service wire, and customer will install underground service wire.

If such applicant pays the village the amount of any estimated cost, and the village extends service to such applicant's single-family dwelling, commercial, governmental or business establishment, trailer or mobile home park, then the village shall refund to the applicant any amount by which such estimated cost exceeds the actual cost incurred by the village, and applicant shall pay to the village any amount by which such actual costs exceeds the estimated cost already paid. In the event that the extension of service mentioned in this Section requires expenditures by the village for equipment, materials, labor, overhead, interest, taxes or engineering studies of an extraordinary nature, the applicant shall pay to the village an additional amount to cover the actual costs of said items.

Section 4. Extension of distribution system.)

Extension of distribution system to new subdivisions, multi-family dwellings, to commercial, governmental and business

establishments and to trailer or mobile home parks will be paid for as provided in this section. For such extension to the village distribution system either (a) prior to the approval of a subdivision plot plan by the Village of Chatham or any agency thereof and prior to the erection, construction and installation of electrical service to subdivisions or (b) prior to the erection, construction and installation of electrical service to business, governmental and commercial establishments or (c) prior to the erection, construction and installation of electrical service to trailer or mobile home parks, or (d) prior to the issuance of a building permit for the construction of any unit mentioned in this Section, the subdivider, owner, or contractor, as the case may be, must obtain from the Village of Chatham, an engineer's cost estimate for providing electrical service to the subdivision, business or commercial establishment, or trailer or mobile home park, said estimate to include all equipment, materials, labor, overhead, interest and taxes, and an engineer's estimate of the cost of all equipment, materials, labor, overhead, interest, and taxes for furnishing electricity to the multi-family dwelling subdivisions (including street lighting), business, governmental, or commercial establishment, or trailer or mobile home park.

The Village may employ an independent contractor to construct such extension of the village distribution system or may do such work by its regular village employees. The determination of whether or not to use an independent contractor will be made by the Village.

Section 3. Effective date. This Ordinance shall  
be in full force and effect immediately after its passage  
and approval.
