

ORDINANCE 79-32  
Incorporating SBI Route No. 4 Alternate into  
the Municipal Street System of the  
Village of Chatham

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, under date of Aug. 28, 1979 the Village of Chatham, a municipal corporation of the State of Illinois petitioned the State of Illinois, through its Department of Transportation, to transfer the jurisdiction of SBI Route No. 4 Alternate extending westward from the intersection of Main Street and Chestnut Street along Chestnut Street to the intersection of Chestnut Street and Church Street for a distance of 752 feet; thence south along Church Street to the intersection of Church Street and marked Illinois Route 4 for a distance of 1700 feet. The total distance being 2452 feet from the State Highway System to the Municipal Street System; and

WHEREAS, the prayer of said petition was granted by said Department of Transportation on \_\_\_\_\_ 19\_\_\_\_.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham that SBI Route No. 4 Alternate extending westward from the intersection of Main Street and Chestnut Street along Chestnut Street to the intersection of Chestnut Street and Church Street for a distance of 752 feet; thence south along Church Street to the intersection of Church Street and marked Illinois Route 4 for a distance of 1700 feet. The total distance being 2452 feet is hereby incorporated into and is hereby made a part of the Municipal Street System of this Village; and

FURTHER, the clerk is hereby directed to transmit one certified copy of this ordinance to the State of Illinois through its District Engineer's office at 126 East Ash Street, Springfield, Illinois 62706.

PETITION

Requesting the Jurisdictional Transfer of (a)  
Certain Street(s) in the Village of Chatham,  
a Municipal Corporation of the State of Illinois.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois, acting through its Department of Transportation, hereinafter called the STATE, has presently under its jurisdiction State Bond Issue Route No. 4 Alternate (referred to as Old Illinois Route 4) extending westward from the intersection of Main Street and Chestnut Street along Chestnut Street to the intersection of Chestnut Street and Church Street for a distance of 752 feet; thence south along Church Street to the intersection of Church Street and marked Illinois Route 4 for a distance of 1700 feet. The total distance being 2452 feet.

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham, a municipal corporation of the State of Illinois, acting through its President and Board of Trustees, hereinafter called the VILLAGE, is desirous of assuming the jurisdiction of the above described route; and

WHEREAS, the authority to approve this petition is granted the STATE by Section 4-409 of the Illinois Highway Code and the deletion from the State Highway System is authorized by Section 2-101 of the Illinois Highway Code.

NOW THEREFORE, the VILLAGE does hereby request that the prayer of this petition be granted by the STATE, transferring the jurisdiction of State Bond Issue Route No. 4 Alternate (referred to as Old Illinois Route 4) extending westward from the intersection of Main Street and Chestnut Street along Chestnut Street to the intersection of Chestnut Street and Church Street for a distance of 752 feet; thence south along

Church Street in the intersection of Church Street and marked Illinois Route 4 for a distance of 1700 feet. The total distance being 2452 feet from the STATE to the VILLAGE by the duly appointed officers of said Department of Transportation affixing their signatures hereto; and


