ORDINANCE 80-3

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 79-11, AS AMENDED

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance 79-11, as amended, is amended by striking Section 3 of Article VIII and inserting in lieu thereof:

"Section 3. In addition to such other remedies available to the Village for violations of this Ordinance, the Village: (a) upon making a determination that a building sewer is connected to a public sewer in a manner prohibited by the terms of this Ordinance, may take or cause to be taken any steps necessary to either plug or disconnect such a connection without giving notice to either the owner or occupant of the real property affected by the plugging or disconnection if:

(1) A notice of violation was served upon the owner of the real estate in the manner prescribed by this Article and a hearing is not requested by the owner to challenge the notice of violation within the prescribed period of time; or

(2) A compelling public interest exists for making the plug or disconnection.

(b) upon making a determination that a violation of Article II, Section 4 or Article III, Section 2 has occurred and is continuing, may take or cause to be taken any steps necessary to terminate or disconnect water service to the subject property without further notice if: (1) The owner or occupant of the premises was served written notice of violation under the provisions of Article VIII and a hearing was not requested by the owner to challenge the notice of violation within the prescribed time, or was served written notice to connect within the 60 day period prescribed in either Article II, Section 4 or Article III, Section 2; or

(2) A compelling public interest exists for the termination or disconnection of water service."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
