WHEREAS the accounting firm of Ernst & Whinney can provide these services through competent professional personnel;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. That the accounting firm of Ernst & Whinney in Springfield, Illinois, is hereby retained for the purpose of providing an audit of the various village funds for the fiscal year ending April 30, 1980 under the terms outlined in the correspondence from that firm to the Village President, Mr. John Whitney.
