AN ORDINANCE IN RELATION TO AMENDING ORDINANCE 75-9, "AN ORDINANCE IN RELATION TO PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY," APPROVED OCTOBER 14, 1975.

Be It Ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Section 5 of Ordinance No. 75-9 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 5. Brush, etc. Nuisance. The presence upon lands lying within the corporate limits of the Village of brush, weeds, dead and dying trees, stumps, roots, obnoxious growth, filth, refuse, garbage, offal, carcasses of dead animals, trash, notor vehicles not currently registered to operate on the Illinois public highways according to the Illinois Motor Vehicle Code or part thereof, motor vehicles not in condition to presently operate on the public highways or part thereof, or other debris, be and is hereby declared to be detrimental to public health and safety, and is declared to be a nuisance, and any person found guilty of causing, erecting or allowing to continue such nuisance shall be punished as provided in Section 17."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
