AN ORDINANCE WITH RESPECT TO
A CONTRACT FOR POLICE PROTECTIVE SERVICES TO THE BAL工-CHATHAM COMMUNITY UNIT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 5, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILIINOIS

WHEREAS, the Village has been requested by the governing authorities of the Community Unit School District Number 5, Sangamon County, Illinois to provide police protection at the properties located outside municipal limits of the Village and known as the Glenwood School Complex and comprised of the Glenwood High School and Junior High School; and

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970 and the statutes of the State of Illinois (Ill. Rev. State., 1977, ch. 127, par. 741 et seq.) approve and encourage contracts between units of government for the exchange of services and inter-governmental co-operation; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham, by its Board of Trustees, finds it to be in the best interests of the citizens of the Village to execute such a contract to provide the services of its professional police department to the said school district, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. The President is hereby authorized to execute, by and in behalf of the Village, that certain contract, heretofore negotiated by and between the Ball-Chatham Community Unit School District No. 5, Sangamon County, Illinois, and the Village, for police protective services to the Glenwood School Complex, a copy of which contract is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval as provided by law; the said contract shall become effective upon execution by all parties thereto.
