

ORDINANCE NO. 81-7

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE DATE FOR INAUGURATION OF  
NEWLY ELECTED VILLAGE OFFICERS.

WHEREAS, the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended, provides:

"The terms of elected municipal officers shall commence at the first regular or special meeting of the corporate authorities during the month of April following the proclamation of the results of the regular municipal election at which such officers were elected, except as may otherwise be provided by ordinance fixing the date for inauguration of newly elected officers of a municipality. No such ordinance shall fix the time for inauguration of newly elected officers later than the first regular or special meeting of the corporate authorities in the month of May following such election."

and

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham is desirous of fixing by ordinance the date for inauguration of such newly elected officers of the Village;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: The terms of elected Village officers, President, Board Members and Village Clerk, shall commence and such officers shall be inaugurated at the first regular or special meeting of the Village Board during the month of May following the proclamation of the results of the regular Village election at which such officers were elected.

Section 2: All ordinances, resolutions and parts thereof in conflict herewith be and the same hereby are repealed.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and approval as provided by law.
