ORDINANCE NO. 81-19

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT WITH BALL-CHATHAM COMMUNITY UNIT SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER 5 AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM TO PROVIDE POLICE SERVICES TO THE SCHOOL DISTRICT AND TO RECEIVE PAYMENT THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham heretofore has contracted with the Ball-Chatham Community Unit School District Number 5 for the Village of Chatham to provide police services to Glenwood High School and Junior High School; and

WHEREAS, Ball-Chatham Community Unit School District Number 5 has requested that the Village of Chatham continue to provide such services; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the School District to acquire the protective services of the Village Police Department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Village of Chatham be and it hereby is authorized to enter into a contract with the Ball-Chatham Community Unit School District Number 5 for the Village of Chatham to provide police services for Glenwood High School and Junior High School and to receive payment therefor, all as set forth in such contract.

Section 2: The Village President and Clerk be and they hereby are authorized and directed to execute such contract on behalf of the Village.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage and approval as provided by law.

AGREEMENT

This agreement entered into this 1st of October, 1981, between the VIIIAGE OF CHATHAM, an Illinois municipal corporation, hereinafter called "Village", and BALL-CHATHAM COMMUNITY UNIT SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER 5, hereinafter called "School District", WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the School District to acquire the protective services of the Village Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Village deems it in the best interests of its citizens to provide such services to the School District.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the respective covenants and agreements of the parties as are hereinafter set forth, and in accordance with the powers granted under Article 7, Section IV of the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970, and under An Act authorizing state and local governing bodies to cooperate in the performance of their responsibilities by contracts and other agreements (§741 et seq., Chapter 127, Illinois Revised Statutes 1977), the parties hereto agree:

- 1. That commencing on the 1st day of October, 1981, the Village shall provide the School District with the police protective services of its duly appointed and swom officers for a term of one (1) year.
 - 2. That such services shall consist of the following:
 - A. Routine surveillance patrols in such manner and frequency as may be from time to time determined by the Chief of Police of the Village in accordance with his best professional judgment.
 - B. Emergency responses to requests for assistance from the School District's Board members or employees, provided, however, that in the event the Village Police Department is mable to respond to my such emergency, it shall immediately request the assistance and services of such other law enforcement agencies including, but not limited to, the Illinois State

Police and the Sangamon County Sheriff's Department, that may exercise powers and jurisdiction under the circumstances.

C. Special services as may from time to time be requested by the Superintendent of the School District, or his duly authorized designee, for crowd and traffic control and general law enforcement at School District sponsored events. Any such request shall be directed in writing to the Chief of Police at lease two (2) weeks in advance of the School District sponsored event for which such special services are requested, and shall include a description of the event, its date, time and expected duration, and an estimate of attendance at such event.

The Chief of Police of the Village shall ascertain and determine in consultation with the Superintendent of the School District or his duly authorized designee the nature and extent of special services to be provided pursuant to any such request.

- 3. That the School District shall pay the Village for such police protective services as are set forth in paragraph 2.A. (Routine Surveillance Patrols) and paragraph 2.B. (Emergency Responses) the sum of Three Thousand Five Hundred (\$3,500.00) Dollars, payable in two (2) equal installments of One Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty (\$1,750.00) Dollars payable on November 1, 1981, and March 1, 1982.
- 4. That the School District shall pay the Village for such police protective services as are set forth in paragraph 2.C. (Special Services) the sum of Nine (\$9.00) Dollars per hour per officer. The Village shall bill the School District for such services at intervals convenient to the Village and such bills shall be paid in full by the School District within thirty (30) days of receipt thereof.
- 5. That police protective services as herein set forth shall be provided at the premises known as the Glenwood School Complex and occupied by Glenwood High School and Junior High School.
- 6. That the Village shall, during the term of this agreement,

 maintain in full force and effect such insurance assinct liability and
 such other casualties and losses as it customarily maintains for officers
 of its Police Department.

7. That the parties hereto shall commence negotiations on any extension or renewal hereof on or before July 1, 1982.

AGREEMENT

Emergency responses to requests for assistance from the School District's Board members or employees, provided, however, that in the event the Village Police Department is unable to respond to any such emergency, it shall immediately request the assistance and services of such other law enforcement agencies including, but not limited to, the Illinois State

Police and the Sangamon County Sheriff's Department, that may exercise powers and jurisdiction under the circumstances.

C. Special services as may from time to time be requested by the Superintendent of the School District, or his duly authorized designee, for crowd and traffic control and general law enforcement at School District sponsored events. Any such request shall be directed in writing to the Chief of Police at lease two (2) weeks in advance of the School District sponsored event for which such special services are requested, and shall include a description of the event, its date, time and expected duration, and an estimate of attendance at such event.

The Chief of Police of the Village shall ascertain and determine in consultation with the Superintendent of the School District or his duly authorized designee the nature and extent of special services to be provided pursuant to any such request.

- 3. That the School District shall pay the Village for such police protective services as are set forth in paragraph 2.A. (Routine Surveillance Patrols) and paragraph 2.B. - 4. That the School District shall pay the Village for such police protective services as are set forth in paragraph 2.C. (Special Services) the sum of Nine (\$9.00) Dollars per hour per officer. The Village shall bill the School District for such services at intervals convenient to the Village and such bills shall be paid in full by the School District within thirty (30) days of receipt thereof.
- 5. That police protective services as herein set forth shall be provided at the premises known as the Glenwood School Complex and occupied by Glenwood High School and Junior High School.
- 6. That the Village shall, during the term of this agreement, maintain in full force and effect such insurance against liability and such other casualties and losses as it customarily maintains for officers of its Police Department.

7. That the parties hereto shall commence negotiations on any extension or renewal hereof on or before July 1, 1982.
