ORDINANCE NO. 81-24

AN ORDINANCE IN REFERENCE TO THE VILLAGE ATTORNEY

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham has need of legal counsel to render legal services to the President and Board of Trustees in regard to questions of law, as they arise from time to time;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the President on behalf of the Village is authorized to execute a contract to retain the law firm of Giffin, Winning, Lindner, Newkirk, Cohen & Bodewes, of Springfield, Illinois, for legal services to the Village of Chatham in the manner and form as follows:

CONTRACT

This Contract, entered this day of 1981, by and between the VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS, an Illinois municipal corporation, hereinafter called "Village", and GIFFIN, WINNING, LINDNER, NEWKIRK, COHEN & BODEWES, attorneys at law of Springfield, Illinois, hereinafter called "Attorneys", WITNESSETH:

Village and Attorneys agree as follows:

- 1. Village hereby retains Attorneys and Attorneys shall provide general legal services to the Village from time to time during the term of this Contract, including but not limited to:
 - A. the rendering of legal research and counsel and written opinions to Village on such legal questions as are presented to Attorneys for their opinion and counsel; and
 - B. representing the Village in such matters pending or which may hereafter be instituted by or against the Village in the courts of the State of Illinois, in the courts of the United States which are located within the State of Illinois and before all administrative agencies and departments of government located in the State of Illinois; and
 - C. preparing and reviewing all ordinances, resolutions, contracts and other documents and undertaking all collections as may be requested; and
 - D. providing Attorneys to attend Village Board and Committee Meetings; and
 - E. providing such other legal services as the President or Trustees may request or direct to Attorneys in writing in their official capacities.
- 2. Village shall pay Attorneys for such services the Attorneys' standard hourly rate charged to Attorneys' corporate

clients, which shall not exceed an increase of ten (10%) per cent per year compounded. Such hourly rate shall be the corporate rate except for matters in litigation, which shall be billed at Attomeys' standard litigation rate. Village shall reimburse Attomeys for all expenses incurred or expended by Attomeys in respect to the business of Village. Attomeys shall submit to Village monthly statements for fees and expenses. Payment shall be made by Village within fifteen (15) days of receipt of each such monthly statement.
