ORDINANCE NO. 84-19

## AN ORDINANCE LIMITING THE CONTRIBUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM FOR PAYMENT OF EMPLOYEES' HEALTH AND HOSPITALIZATION GROUP INSURANCE PREMIUMS.

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham heretofore has contracted for employees' health and hospitalization insurance and has paid premiums thereon for employees; and

WHEREAS, the Village is desirous of fixing, limiting and amending the portion of the monthly premium for employees' health and hospitalization insurance which the Village in the future shall be authorized to pay;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLACE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Village of Chatham shall contribute to the monthly premium of employees' health and hospitalization group insurance under coverage contracted for by the Village an amount not to exceed  $(\frac{1}{5}, \frac{1}{2}, \frac{5}{2}, \frac{5}{2}$ 

<u>Section 2</u>: Withholding from employee compensation for payment of the employee's share of such insurance premium, if any is required under this Ordinance, shall commence with the next employee compensation payment period following the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 3: All existing Ordinances or any parts thereof in conflict with any provision of this Ordinance are repealed.

Section 4	: This Ordinance	shall be	effective	upon	passage	
and approval as pro	wided by law.
