- (1) Grantee's sanitary sewer connecting line shall be placed at a depth, constructed of materials, connected and in all other manners installed in strict conformance with the requirements of the Springfield Sanitary District, and all ordinances of the Village of Chatham.
- (2) Grantee shall be responsible for all permits, fees and costs required to make connection to the Springfield Sanitary Sewer System.
- (3) Grantee covenants to grade, level, seed, and otherwise restore the surface of the lands of Grantor disturbed or damaged by the placement of

the Grantee's sewer line beneath the surface, and as a result of the movement of equipment and work upon and across the surface, both in the initial construction and all subsequent maintenance, repair or removal work.
