ORDINANCE NO. 89-1

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO TRAFFIC STOP INTERSECTIONS AND SIGNS

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham Board of Trustees has completed a study of sign placement for the Village in order to facilitate the free flow of traffic and to insure safety to the motoring public and, based upon such study, the Village Board of Trustees has now determined (1) that it is in the public interest to reaffirm the existing placement of stop intersections and related stop signs, and (2) to designate a number of new stop intersections in the Village and to erect new stop signs at such intersections; and

WHEREAS, the Village has had in existence and in force Ordinance No. 76-4 passed and approved February 10, 1976 designating a number of then-new stop intersections within the Village of Chatham, the provisions of which are still appropriate and are hereby reaffirmed herein, but by reason of the substantial growth of the Village since 1975, additional stop sign placements are required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. New Stop Intersections and Signs. No person shall drive any vehicle into the intersections of the following named streets without bringing the vehicle to a full stop and waiting for the traffic to clear on the street with the right-of-way:

Appropriate stop signs shall be posted at all such intersections.

Section 2. Penalty. Any person convicted of a violation of failing to stop, as required by this ordinance, at a stop sign shall be punished by fine as set forth in the relevant Illinois Revised Statutes in force from time to time.

Section 3. Reaffirming Prior Ordinance. Ordinance No. 76-4 "AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO TRAFFIC STOP INTERSECTIONS AND SIGNS" passed and approved February 10, 1976 is hereby reaffirmed as of the effective date of this Ordinance No. 89-1.

Section 4. Publication and Effective Date. This
Ordinance shall be published in a newspaper serving the
Village of Chatham within 30 days after its passage, and
shall also be published in pamphlet form. This Ordinance
shall take effect 10 days after its newspaper publication.
