## ORDINANCE 89-6

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## ORDINANCE TO REVISE THE RATES AND CHARGES FOR THE USE AND SERVICE OF ELECTRIC CURRENT

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 78-27 passed and approved October 24, 1978, entitled "AN ORDINANCE TO REVISE THE VILLAGE LAW FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF ELECTRIC ENERGY AND TO FIX THE RATES AND CHARGES THEREFOR" consists of sixteen (16) paragraphs in all;

WHEREAS, the passage of time and arrangements for a different source of electric energy to the Village make it necessary and desirable that the rate charges as set forth in said Ordinance No. 78-27 be revised;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

I. That Section 16 of said Ordinance No. 78-27 passed and approved October 24, 1978 shall be and is hereby deleted and of no further force and effect.

II. That the following is hereby adopted as and for said Section 16 of an ORDINANCE TO REVISE THE RATES AND CHARGE FOR THE USE AND SERVICE OF ELECTRIC CURRENT:

SECTION 16: There shall be and there are hereby established rates and charges for the use and service of electric for light and power based upon electricity consumed as recorded by electric meters based upon the type of premises served as follows:

## (A) STANDARD RESIDENTIAL SERVICE RATE

(1) <u>Rate</u>:

\$0.055 Net per KWH

(2) Customer Charge:

\$5.00 per month

(3) Fuel Adjustment:

As per general terms and conditions (see Section 17)

(4) Application:

All residential customers for single-phase service taken through a single meter for domestic use.

(5) Tax:

As per Section 5.

(B) SENIOR CITIZEN RESIDENTIAL SERVICE RATE

(1) <u>Rate</u>:

\$0.049 Net per KWH

(2) <u>Customer Charge</u>:

\$5.00 per month

(3) Fuel Adjustment:

As per general terms and conditions (see Section 17).

## (4) <u>Application</u>:

Retired persons having attained the age of sixtytwo (62) years where there is no one residing in the residence for which electric service is provided who is employed. Written application for this favorable rate must be presented during the month of April each year for service during the twelve (12) month period of June 1 through May 31 next following. The Village Board shall consider all said written applications at the first regular meeting in May of each year and approval of the Village Board is required for the rate to be applicable. A new application must be made each year.

(5) <u>Tax</u>:

As per Section 5.

- (C) VILLAGE PARKS
  - (1) Rate:

\$0.046 Net per KWH

(2) Customer Charge:

\$5.00 per month

(3) Fuel Adjustment:

As per general terms and conditions (see Section 17)

(4) <u>Tax</u>:

As per Section 5.

- (D) GENERAL SERVICE COMMERCIAL
  - (1) <u>Rate</u>:
    - (a) <u>Demand</u> <u>Charge</u>:

Winter (November through March) \$2.783/kw demand

Summer (April through October) \$3.333/kw demand

(b) Energy Charge:

Winter (November through March) 6.00¢/kwh

Summer (April through October) 6.27¢/kwh

- (2) <u>Rate</u>: Commercial users without demand meters
  - (a) Winter (November through March) 7.5¢/kwh

Summer (April through October) 7.85¢/kwh

(3) <u>Fuel</u> <u>Adjustment</u>:

As per general terms and conditions (see Section 17).

(4) Customer Charge:

\$6.00/month

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(5) Determination of Demand:

The demand will be the highest average kilowatt demand measured in any 15-minute period during the month.

(6) <u>Application</u>:

Commercial, institutional, and non-residential or for three-phase, residential, non-residential, institutional, and commercial use taken through a single meter at the utility standard secondary voltage.

(7) Nature of Service:

Service will be delivered at no more than one utilization voltage, one point of delivery, and one meter; any exception to the foregoing will be treated as supplemental facilities.

Alternating current, 60 cycle, single phase, 120/240 nominal volts;

Alternating current, 60 cycle, three phase, 120/240 nominal volts;

When available and at the customer's request, the utility will supply the following for combined light and power:

Alternating current, 60 cycle, three-phase, 120/208 nominal volts.

(8) <u>Tax</u>:

As per Section 5.

- (E) INDUSTRIAL SERVICE
  - (1) <u>Rate</u>:
    - (a) Demand Charge:

Winter (November through March) \$3.894 per kw demand

Summer (April through October) \$4.444 per kw demand

(b) Energy Charge:

Winter (November through March) \$4.88¢ per kwh

Summer (April through October) \$5.43¢ per kwh

(2) Customer Charge:

\$100.00 per month

(3) Fuel Adjustment:

As per general terms and conditions (see Section 17).

- (4) <u>Determination of Demand</u>:
  - (a) The Chatham Electric Department at its option, may determine the customer's actual demand, either by permanently installed demand instruments or by demand tests. The demand will be the highest average kilowatt demand measured in any 15-minute period during the month.
  - (b) The minimum demand shall be seventy (70) kw.

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(5) <u>Application</u>:

Commercial, industrial or manufacturing facility.

(6) <u>Nature of Services</u>:

See Section 16C(7).

(7) <u>Tax</u>:

As per Section 5.

In all other respects, except as expressly modified herein, Electric Energy Ordinance passed and adopted on October 24, 1978 shall remain in full force  $\mathcal J$  and effect.
