

ORDINANCE NO. 89-11 17

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE POSITION AND
COMPENSATION FOR VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR

WHEREAS, the Illinois Revised Statutes, 1975, Chapter 24, paragraphs 3-8-1, 3-7-1, grant authority to villages to establish the position of administrator and allow them to endow such an office with certain administrative powers; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham has a demonstrated need to conduct business in the most efficient manner;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1.: Commencing May 9, 1989, Ordinance 85-M-2 is by Ordinance 89-11 dissolved.

SECTION 2: Commencing May 9, 1989, the position of Village Administrator is established. The compensation will be \$30,400² a year, beginning May 16, 1989, payable in equal periodic installments at the same times as other village employees for the following named person:

LELAND McCORD

SECTION 3.: Holder of said position shall be the administrative head of office personnel and all other village employees, ~~excluding police~~. In this position, the administrator is authorized to make a study of and initiate changes in all village procedures and support services with the advice and consent of the Village Board where appropriate.

SECTION 4.: This ordinance shall be effective upon passage and approved as provided by law.
