## ORDIANCE NO. 89- 3/

## AN ORDIANCE CREATING A MINOR SUBDIVISION

WHEREAS, Richard O. Telford heretofore has requested the creation of a minor subdivision under the provision of section XIV of the 1981 Subdivision Regulations of the Village of Chatham, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Chatham Planning Commission has recommended a variance to section X-13-I of the Subdivision Regulations in regards to access to the subject subdivision via a private road; and

WHEREAS, the Chatham Planning Commission, because of unique circumstances and existing conditions, has also recommended that the requested minor subdivision be granted, upon submittal of a completed final plat as defined in section XIV of the 1981 Subdivision Regulations; and

WHEREAS, heretofore the Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham granted due to unique circumstances, a variance to section V of the Zoning Ordiance of the Village of Chatham.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, AND THE STATE OF ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>: The application of the regulations of Section X-13-I of the 1981 Subdivision ordinace of the Village of Chatham, Illinois, is hereby varied to permit a access to the subject properties via private road.

<u>Section 2</u>: A minor subdivision is granted to Richard 0. Telford for the following described real estate:
