## ORDINANCE NO. 89-43

## AN ORDINANCE MAKING SUPPLIMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS OF SUMS OF MONEY NECESSARY TO DEFRAY NECESSARY EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING APRIL 30, 1990.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate sums of money for the transaction of the normal and customary business and affairs of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the making of an appropriation for any purpose does not necessarily mean that the amount appropriated, or any portion thereof, will be paid out, but constitutes merely a condition precedent for expenditure of Village funds; and

WHEREAS, additional revenue has become available to the Village of Chatham as a result of passage of Public Act 86-18; and

WHEREAS, the intent to this ordinance is to affect revenue not available for appropriation when the most recent annual appropriation ordinance was passed; and

WHEREAS, the publication, notice and public hearing requirements of Section 8-2-6 of the Illinois Municipal Code do not apply to supplemental appropriations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

**SECTION I:** That the following sums of money from the Income Tax Surcharge Local Government Distributive Fund be, and the same are hereby appropriated for the corporate purposes and objects of said Village hereinafter specified for the fiscal year commencing May 1, 1989, and ending on April 30, 1990:

PUBLIC SAFETY	-\$3,000
HUMAN SERVICES	- \$ 19,400
RECREATION	- \$141,500

#### SUMMARY

Total supplemental appropriations for the fiscal year ending April 30, 1990:

\$ 163,900

<u>SECTION II</u>: This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication. PASSED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County,
