ORDINANCE NO. 89-49

WHEREAS, bids or proposals have been sought and obtained from three sellers of computer equipment for a computer system for the Village of Chatham; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees have reviewed the various bids and proposals received; and

WHEREAS, the bid from Mentor, while not the lowest bid, is the lowest bid wherein all equipment will be supplied by a single contractor; and

WHEREAS, funds sufficient for the purchase of such equipment have been appropriated for such purchase;

THEREFORE, be it ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Illinois, that:

Section 1. The bid to sell a computer system, as made by Mentor, of Lexington, Kentucky, is accepted, and the President and Clerk are authorized to execute a contract with such seller, to purchase such system as listed on the attached exhibit, for the sum of \$87,447.00.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 89-47, passed on November 1, 1989, is bereby repealed.

<u>Section 3</u>. This Ordinance No. 89-49 shall be effective from and after its passage.
