

ORDINANCE NO. 90-17

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING VILLAGE EXPENDITURES

WHEREAS, no appropriation ordinance for fiscal year May 1, 1990 to April 30, 1991 has been enacted by the corporate authorities of the Village of Chatham; and

WHEREAS, pending the passage of such annual appropriation ordinance, the corporate authorities of the Village of Chatham have authority to and may make necessary expenditures upon the basis of the appropriations of the preceding fiscal year as provided in Section 8-1-7 of the Illinois Municipal Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Pending the passage of the annual appropriation ordinance for fiscal year May 1, 1990 to April 30, 1991, heads of departments or other separate agencies of the Village be and they hereby are authorized, beginning May 1, 1990, to make necessary expenditures for the support thereof upon the basis of the appropriations of the preceding fiscal year (May 1, 1989 to April 30, 1990).

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on May 1, 1990.
