## ELECTRIC REBATE PROPOSAL

- 1. Developer would pay Village \$1800 per lot up front at time of platting subdivision. This is estimated per lot cost and would change from time to time. Funds would be deposited in electric fund.
- 2. Village would build electric system (both streetlights and residential) for developer with costs paid by electric fund.
  - 3. Village would rebate \$900 per lot to developer, as follows:
- Semi-annually, developer would apply for rebate and list lots for which rebate is requested;
- Developer is eligible for rebate when lot is sold <u>and</u> customer relationship is established with new resident (not contractor);
- Village is liable to pay rebate only if funds are available in electric fund over and above reserves required by bond covenants or prudent management;
- Rebates made semiannually. If more than one developer applies and there are limited dollars available, rebates are prorated among developers;
- If no rebate is made due to insufficient funds, rebate eligibility would carry over to next period;
  - Village not liable to account for or pay interest to developer.
