

ORDINANCE NO. 90-20

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 80-17 OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM BY REVISING CERTAIN FEES AND CHARGES TO BE CHARGED IN CONNECTION WITH THE CHATHAM MEMORIAL AND CHATHAM COMMUNITY CEMETERY AND AMENDING CERTAIN OTHER PROVISIONS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 80-17 of the Village of Chatham, Illinois, the Board of Trustees provided for and adopted certain charges in connection with the operation and maintenance of the municipal cemeteries commonly known as **CHATHAM MEMORIAL CEMETERY AND CHATHAM COMMUNITY CEMETERY**; and

WHEREAS, The Village Board has determined that it is necessary to increase certain fees charged for the acquisition of burial plots and grave openings and closings; and

WHEREAS, The Village Board has also determined that the distribution of the fees for future care of the Chatham Memorial and Chatham Community Cemetery is desirable.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 80-17 of the Village of Chatham is hereby amended by deleting the text contained therein and substituting in lieu thereof the following:

"The following schedule of fees and charges is hereby established with respect to acquisition of burial plots from and with respect to grave openings and closings by the Village of Chatham in Chatham Memorial and Chatham Community Cemetery;

- A. Effective upon passage, the "phase-in" schedule of fees for the purchase of a burial plot in issuance of a deed will be as follows:
 1. \$25.00 if purchased on or before July 19, 1990.
 2. \$100.00 if purchased on or after July 20, 1990 and on or before August 19, 1990.
 3. \$200.00 if purchased on or after August 20, 1990 and on or before October 19, 1990.
 4. If purchased on or after October 20, 1990 the sum of \$400.00 per burial plot (grave).
- B. For a grave opening and closing there shall be charged the sum of \$250.00, including weekends and holidays.

The Treasurer of the Village of Chatham shall keep a cemetery account into which all money received or paid out on account of Chatham Memorial and Chatham Community Cemetery shall be credited or charged. The Treasurer shall report such receipts and expenditures to the Board of Trustees.

SECTION 2. Upon receipt of funds for the purchase of a burial plot in the Chatham Memorial or the Chatham Community Cemetery, the Treasurer shall deposit such funds into the perpetual care fund heretofore established for the continuing maintenance and care of the two cemeteries.

SECTION 3. Upon receipt of funds for a grave opening and closing, the Treasurer shall deposit the proceeds received into the operating account of the cemetery for the payment of ordinary expenses in connection with the operation of the Chatham Memorial and the Chatham Community Cemetery.

SECTION 4. All ordinances, resolutions and parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage, approval and publication as provided by law. The Clerk shall forthwith publish this Ordinance in the Pamphlet form.
