ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE

An Ordinance making appropriations for all corporate purposes for the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois, for the fiscal year commencing on the 1st day of May, A.D., 1990, and ending on the 30th day of April, A.D., 1991.
