ORDINANCE NO. 90- 35

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A PREVAILING WAGE FOR THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted "An Act Regulating Wages of Laborers, Mechanics, and Other Workers Employed in Any Public Works by the State, County, City or Any Public Body or Any Political Subdivision or by Anyone Under Contract for Public Works", approved June 26, 1941, as amended (Ill.Rev.Stat. 1989, ch. 48, par. 39s-1, <u>et seq</u>.) (the "Act"); and

WHEREAS, the Act requires that the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois, investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in said Act for laborers, mechanics, and other workers in the locality of said Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois, employed in performing construction of public works, for said Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> To the extent and as required by the Act, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workers engaged in construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois, is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in the Sangamon County area as of June, 1990, as determined by the Department of Labor, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference. The definition of any terms appearing in this Ordinance which are also used in the Act shall be the same as in the Act.

SECTION 2. Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction of the Village of Chatham, Illinois, to the extent required by the Act.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> The Clerk of the Village of Chatham, Illinois, shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois, this determination or any revisions of the prevailing rate of wages. A copy of this determination or of any revised determination of prevailing rate of wages then in effect shall be attached to all contract specifications.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> The Clerk of the Village of Chatham, Illinois, shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workers whose wages will be affected by such rates.

SECTION 5. The Clerk of the Village of Chatham, Illinois, shall promptly file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Secretary of State Index Division.

SECTION 6. The Clerk of the Village of Chatham, Illinois, shall cause to be published in a newspaper of general circulation

within the area a notice in the form of Exhibit "B" hereto that this determination of this public body is effective.

ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF LABOR PREVAILING WAGES FOR SANGAMON COUNTY EFFECTIVE 06/01/90

These Prevailing Wages shall be included in the contracts and their advertised specifications to which any public body, as defined in Section 2 of the Prevailing Wage Act (III. Rev. Stat. 1987, Ch. 48, par. 39s-1), is a party, for the construction, reconstruction, maintenance and/or repair of public buildings or public works within the State of Illinois which requires or involves the employment of laborers, workers, and mechanics, and owner/operators. Minimum wages, overtime rate and fringe benefits certified herein shall be paid. This scale of prevailing wages to be paid shall be posted by the contractor in a prominent and easily accessible place at the site of work. This determination is the property of the Illinois Department of Labor and shall not be altered without their consent in writing.

Dear Carl:

I enclose a prevailing wage ordinance for passage at your next board meeting. You will recall that earlier this year at the request of Joe Greene the Village passed a prevailing wage ordinance that he could use in connection with motor fuel projects. Tom Kelty pointed out to me that although that ordinance was OK, the Village still needs to do a prevailing wage ordinance using the rates specified by the Department of Labor for June, 1990. The earlier ordinance had the April rates. This ordinance has the June rates, and these rates will be good for a year.

Please note also that there are two other differences between this ordinance and the former one. This ordinance requires a certified copy to be filed with the Index Division of the Secretary of State and it requires a notice of the prevailing wage determination to be published in the local newspaper. These are two statutory requirements that were overlooked in the prior ordinance but should be observed for this ordinance and in the future.
