MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 9/-11

Providing for the addition of Gordon Drive from a point .18 miles north of the north edge of pavement of Walnut Street to a point .38 miles north of the north edge of pavement of Walnut Street to the Municipal Street System of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois.

Whereas the Village of Chatham and the County of Sangamon have entered into an agreement for transfer of jurisdiction of Gordon Drive to the Municipal Street System.

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham that Gordon Drive from a point .18 miles north of the north edge of pavement of Walnut Street to a point .38 miles north of the north edge of pavement of Walnut Street be added to the Municipal Street System.

The Village Clerk is directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to the State of Illinois through its District Engineer's office at Springfield, Illinois.
