I just received the ordinance and have had a chance to review it. The ordinance does not have a bond form. No rush, but please send me one.

This issue was pre-1986 tax reform. In order to amend the ordinance into an acceptable post-1986 tax reform structure, the amendments would be quite comprehensive. In general, under these circumstances, it will be as convenient to just currently refund the bonds in a more normal way. Would the present holder waive the 30-day notice and just exchange on the closing date? With the ordinance in hand, I can firm a quote to you of \$2,750 plus approximately \$200 of related costs to effect the above refunding.
