

ORDINANCE NO. 91- 62

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH DWIGHT ELLIOTT,
RON WOOD, DON O'CONNOR AND GARRY HAWK.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
