ORDINANCE NO. 94-29

AN ORDINANCE RE-AWARDING THE BID FOR SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, the low bid from Vandenbergh Concrete for \$19,800 was accepted by the Village on February 8, 1994; and

WHEREAS, Vandenbergh Concrete was authorized to precede on March 8, 1994 by Ordinance 94-14, with work to be complete by May 1, 1994; and

WHEREAS, to this date no work has commenced on the project, the Public Works Committee has determined it to be in the best interest of the Village to award the project to the second lowest bid by L. W. Rolland Trucking Service, Inc. for \$21,532.90.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The contract with Vandenbergh Concrete is terminated for nonperformance. The project is awarded to L.W. Rolland Trucking Service, Inc., and the Village Administrator is authorized to enter into a contract with L.W. Rolland in the form that was part of the package.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is effective upon its passage and approval.
