ORDINANCE NO. 94-30

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN ADDITIONAL POLICE OFFICER POSITION

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham Police Department presently consists of a police chief, two sergeants, and five full-time police officers; and

WHEREAS, the Administrative Committee is recommending an increase in force of one; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village desire to increase the number of full-time police officers in the Village by one.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The authorized strength of the Police Department is hereby increased by one person, to consist of a police chief, two sergeants, and six full-time police officers.

SECTION 2: The Village Administrator shall direct the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners to select an additional police officer to take office at a time to be determined by the Village Administrator.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on its passage and approval as required by law.
