Ordinance No. 94-35

AN ORDINANCE FIXING RATES AND CHARGES FOR WATER AND WATER SERVICES FURNISHED BY THE WATERWORKS SYSTEM OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 70-7, the Village established rates for water supplied to the waterworks system of the Village of Chatham;

WHEREAS, the rates provided by Ordinance No. 70-7 have been amended from time to time, including an amendment passed in August, 1982, Ordinance No. 82-22, which increased the rates provided in Section 5 of Ordinance No. 70-7 and instituted a purchased water adjustment clause by addition of Section 14 to Ordinance No. 70-7.

WHEREAS, the Village wishes to eliminate the purchased water adjustment clause and to readjust water rates from time to time by Ordinance as needed to meet the income requirements of the waterworks system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section 5 of Ordinance No. 70-7 is amended to state as follows:

SECTION 5: The following shall be the rates for water supplied through the waterworks system of the Village, payable monthly within 15 days after rendition of each bill.

Volume	Inside <u>Village Limits</u>	Outside <u>Villaqe Limits</u>	
Minimum 0-2,000 gal/month	\$8.50	\$11.10	
All Over 2,000 gal/month	\$3.00 per 1,000 gal.	\$4.35 per 1,000 gal.	

A separate minimum charge shall be made for each apartment, place of business or dwelling unit in all buildings containing two or more apartments, places of

business or family units; however, no minimum charge shall be made for any vacant apartment, place of business or dwelling unit which is vacant during an entire month, provided that the water department has been notified in writing of such vacancy.

In addition to the foregoing rates, there shall be charged to the Chatham Fire Protection District the sum of \$22.00 per year for each fire hydrant connected to the waterworks systems for fire protection. This charge may be waived at the discretion of the Village President.

Further, the charge for bulk water sales shall be \$3.00 per 1,000 gallons.

The Village reserves the right to make changes in rates and conditions in its discretion and to establish further rules and regulations from time to time.

SECTION 2: Section 14 of Ordinance No. 70-7, which was added by Ordinance No. 82-22, is hereby repealed. All other sections of Ordinance No. 70-7 and 82-22 not specifically modified or repealed by this Ordinance shall continue in effect.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect with respect to bills due on or after August 15, 1994. The Clerk shall forthwith publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.
