

Ordinance No. 97-22

**AN ORDINANCE  
GRANTING A SPECIAL USE PERMIT  
(GOLDEN SENIOR CARE)**

WHEREAS, on May 10, 1997, Golden Senior Care Corporation requested a special use permit for Property having a legal description of Lot 120 of Oakbrook Estates Plat 3, Chatham, Illinois, to allow its use as an assisted care facility in an area zoned R-2;

WHEREAS, notice of the requested rezoning and special use permit and the hearing thereon was published in the Chatham Clarion, a newspaper of general circulation within the Village of Chatham on May 26, 1997;

WHEREAS, a public hearing was conducted by the Planning Commission of the Village of Chatham on June 5, 1997;

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees find it to be in the best interest of the Village of Chatham to grant the requested special use permit;

*NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, AS FOLLOWS:*

**SECTION 1:** The property legally described as Lot 120 of Oakbrook Estates Subdivision, Plat 3, Chatham, Illinois, is hereby granted a special use permit to allow its use as an assisted care facility in an R-2 zone.

**SECTION 2:** This Ordinance is effective immediately.
