ORDINANCE 97-34

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE EXTENSION OF MEDICAL INSURANCE TO RETIREES

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham provides Medical Insurance coverage to all active personnel as a benefit of employment; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham does not currently provide Medical Insurance as a continued benefit to retired employees; and

WHEREAS, the Public Properties and Services Committee has reviewed the policy and is recommending the Medical Insurance benefit be extended to retired personnel who meet the to be established guidelines.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The Village of Chatham shall extend the benefit of Medical Insurance coverage to retired personnel who meet the following guidelines as of the date of their retirement:

- The employee must have worked a minimum of 10 years for the Village of Chatham.
- The employee must have been insured under the approved Village plan for a minimum of five (5) years.
- The employee must be a minimum of sixty (60) years of age the date of their retirement.
- The employee may be covered under this plan to a maximum age of sixty five (65).

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is effective upon passage and approval, as provided by law.
