

Ordinance No. 97-71

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village of Chatham have proposed an amendment to the zoning ordinance of the Village of Chatham which would add a golf course as a permitted use in the B-1 community business district zone and in the B-2 general business district zone.

WHEREAS, after public notice in the *Chatham Clarion* on October 9, 1997, at a public hearing conducted on October 27, 1997, the Planning Commission considered the proposed change to the zoning ordinance and recommended approval to the Village Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section 3.04 (h) of the Zoning Ordinance of the Village of Chatham is amended by addition of "golf course" as a permitted use in the B-1 community business district zone.

SECTION 2: Section 3.04 (i) of the Zoning Ordinance of the Village of Chatham is amended by the addition of "golf course" as a permitted use in the B-2 general business district zone.

SECTION 3: This ordinance is effective immediately.
