AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH ROY SKAGGS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That the Roy Skaggs shall be paid \$400.00 monthly for the following activities:

- 1. Meet with the office and family to select and purchase cemetery plot.
- 2. Meet with the digger or assist 1 village employee in digging grave.
- 3. Mark out plot and meet with the Funeral Home to set-up for service.
- 4. Be at cemetery for service, direct traffic and generally represent the Village.
- 5. Fill-in around grave after service.
- 6. Meet with monument company for installation of headstones.
- 7. Install corner markers for plots.
- 8. Assist office personnel with cemetery records.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is effective upon its passage and approval.
