- 4. The Village may enforce this Agreement at law or in equity, and in the event thereof, shall be entitled to its attorneys fees and expenses.
- 5. In addition to any other remedy at law or in equity, should Officer resign from the Village's employ or be terminated by the Village within two years of Officer's graduation from PTI, the Village will be entitled to liquidated damages in the amount of \$2,000, since the parties agree that the damages to the Village, while substantial, would be difficult to ascertain.
