## AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A LETTER OF CREDIT SECURING CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS FOR OAKBROOK ESTATES PLATS 1 THROUGH 6

WHEREAS, the developer of Oakbrook Estates Subdivision has requested to consolidate all security instruments securing construction of public improvements for Oakbrook Estates Plats 1 through 6;

WHEREAS, by letter dated May 26, 1999, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", the Consulting Engineers for the Village approved security for all remaining public improvements for Plats 1 through 6 in the amount of \$75,000;

WHEREAS, Merchantile Bank has provided its Letter of Credit No.1783 to stand as security for construction of public improvements in Plats 1 through 6 of Oakbrook Estates Subdivision; and a copy of that Letter of Credit is attached hereto as Exhibit "B";

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1**: Letter of Credit No. 1783 issued by Merchantile Bank on June 8, 1999 in the amount of \$75,000 is hereby approved as security for construction of remaining public improvements on Oakbrook Estates Plats 1 through 6, and all previous security with respect to these plats is hereby released.

**SECTION 2:** This Ordinance is effective immediately.

Except as so far as otherwise stated, this credit is subject to the Uniform Customs and Practices of Documentary Credits (1993 revision) International Chamber of Commerce, Publication No. 500.

This Letter of Credit shall be automatically extended for an additional period of one year from the present or each future expiration date unless we have notified you in writing, not less than sixty (60) days before such expiration date, that we elect not to renew this Letter of Credit.
