

AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO ACCEPTANCE OF ITEMS OF PERSONAL PROPERTY DONATED TO THE CHATHAM DEPOT

WHEREAS, a now defunct corporation known as Friends of the Depot accepted donations of a number of items of personal property pertaining to railroading history in the Village of Chatham;

WHEREAS, these items of personal property were given by the Friends of the Depot to the Chicago Illinois Midland Chapter of the National Railway Historical Society; ("Society"), and the Society wishes the Village to have title to the items;

WHEREAS, the Society has a management agreement with the Village whereby the society manages the Village Depot as a railroading museum;

WHEREAS, the Village wishes to grant authority to the Society to keep the items in its possession, and to accept further items which might be donated to the Village, as agents for the Village;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The Village hereby accepts title to items of personal property listed in Exhibits A and B hereto; which were donated to the Friends of the Depot and which were given by Friends of the Depot to the Society. The Village hereby designates the Society as custodian of these items, which will be kept and maintained at the Chatham Depot.

SECTION 2: The Village hereby designates the Society as its agent to accept additional donations of items related to railroading history. In every case where items are accepted, they will be receipted for by the Society on a form attached hereto as Exhibit C, and the Society will in each case provide a copy of each receipt to the Village.

SECTION 3: The Society will from time to time, but not less than every two years, perform a physical inventory of donated items in its possession and update the lists of items as exemplified as Exhibits A and B hereto, and provide the updated list to the Village.


SECTION 4: This ordinance is effective immediately.

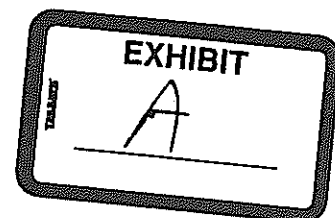

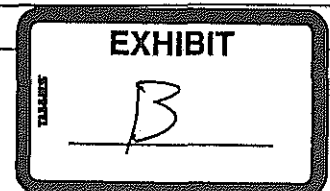
