Ordinance No. 00- <u>20</u>

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE NUMBER OF LIQUOR LICENSES TO BE ISSUED BY THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM AND AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM CODE OF ORDINANCES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section 111.17(I) of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Chatham is amended to state as follows:

- (I) The number of licenses issued by the Village shall be as follows:
 - (1) There may be four Class C licenses;
 - (2) There may be one Class G license;
 - (3) There may be one Class N license;
 - (4) There may be two Class P licenses;
 - (5) There may be one Class R-1 license;
 - (6) There may be no Class R-2 licenses;
 - (7) There may be one Class SE license outstanding at any time;
 - (8) There may be three Class T licenses.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is effective upon its passage and approval. However, the sole Class R-2 licensee who has applied for a Class T license prior to the passage of this ordinance may continue to operate for up to 30 days under the terms of its R-2 license pending approval of the T license application. The Clerk shall see to the inclusion of this ordinance in the next published update of the Village Code of Ordinances.
