AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A BID FOR LIGHTS
FOR BASEBALL AND FOOTBALL FIELDS IN COMMUNITY PARK

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham received \$150,000 from the State of Illinois for improvements at Chatham Community Park. The lighting of baseball field four, seating at field four, and limited security lighting along the bike path; and

WHEREAS, the Chatham Junior Football League informed the Village that they have the funds and the desire to light one football field in Community Park.

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham sought and obtained bids for the lighting of both fields, to be paid by the Electric Fund, and reimbursed by the appropriate source; and


WHEREAS, the attached bids were opened and the lowest responsible bidder identified.


SECTION 1: That the bid from Universal Sports Lighting for \$50,300.00 for the Baseball field and \$25,760 for the Football Field are hereby approved.

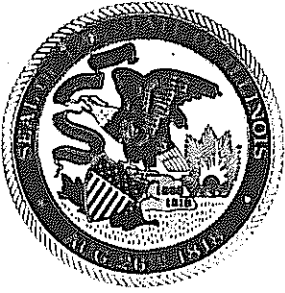
