

ORDINANCE NO. 00-63

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARADES IN THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham desires a orderly and safe progression of parade participants as well as providing safety for motorists and those viewing the parade.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: A permit, at no cost, for a Parade shall be requested from the Police Department no latter than 14 days prior to the date of the parade and shall select one of the two parade routes attached hereto marked as "Exhibit A" and "Exhibit B".


SECTION 2: This Ordinance is effective upon its passage and approval.

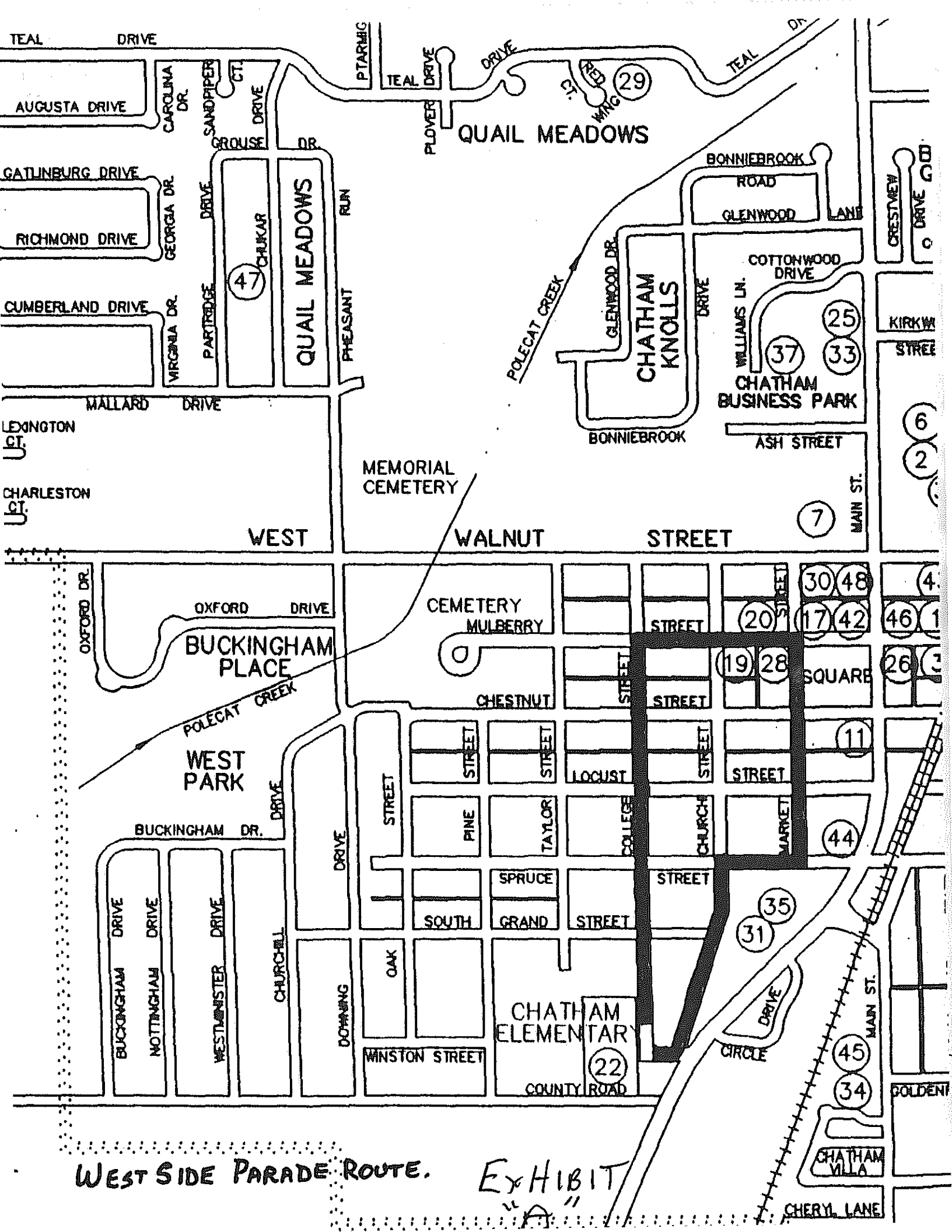

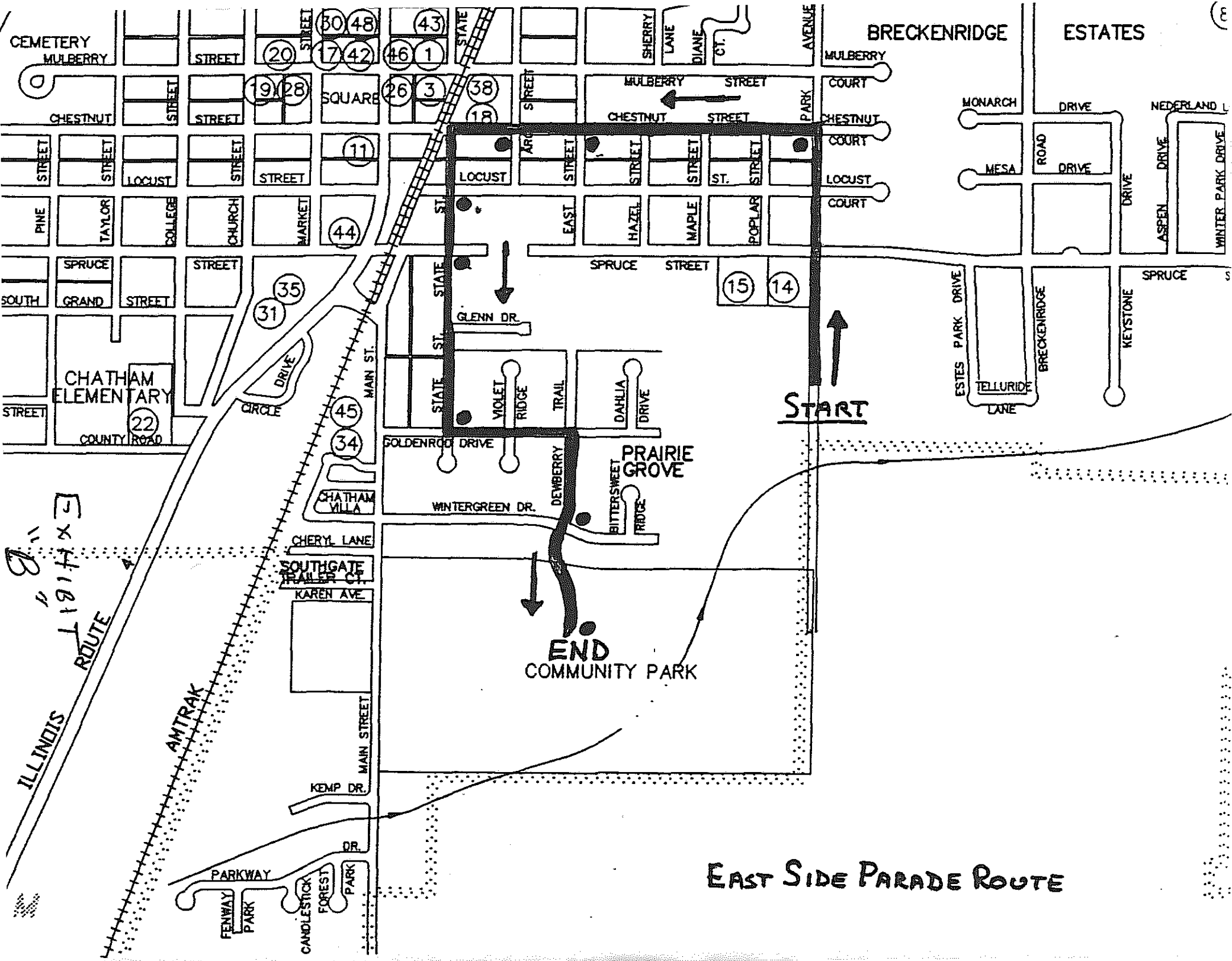
