## ORDINANCE NO. 01-12

**AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING AND ELECTING THE ACQUISITION  
AND OPERATION OF A COMMON SOURCE OF SUPPLY OF WATER.**

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois, has heretofore conducted discussions with the Village of Rochester, Sangamon County, Illinois, concerning the acquisition and development of a common source of supply of water for distribution by each Village to its customers through its respective waterworks facility; and,

WHEREAS, the Villages of Chatham and Rochester (the "Villages") have heretofore authorized a Feasibility Study to be conducted by Environmental Management Corporation of Illinois; and,

WHEREAS, the Feasibility Study conducted by EMC of Illinois has been received and approved by the Boards of Trustees of the Villages; and,

WHEREAS, in part, the conclusions of the Feasibility Study accepted by the Boards of Trustees concluded that an appropriate manner of operation of the joint water supply to be acquired by the Villages would be through a Water Commission authorized by Division 135 of Article 11 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 11-135-1 et. seq.); and,

WHEREAS, in order to cause the organization of the Water Commission and secure the participation of the Village of Chatham in the Commission, it is necessary that the Village Board of the Village of Chatham adopt an Ordinance authorizing the Village's participation in said Water Commission and certain other activities in connection therewith;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the preambles hereto are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference as if fully set forth at this point.

Section 2. That pursuant to authority granted by Section 1 of Division 135 of Article 11 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-135-1) the Village of Chatham hereby elects to acquire and operate jointly with the Village of Rochester a common source of

supply of water pursuant to the provisions of Division 135.

Section 3. That the Village of Chatham hereby obligates itself to bear a proportionate share of the development costs for determination of the feasibility of such a common source of supply of water in an amount not to exceed \$ 5000; said sum to be paid to the Chatham-Rochester Water Commission upon notification by the Commission that it has organized itself and is prepared to conduct its affairs.

Section 4. That all Ordinances and Resolutions of the Village in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed to the extent of said conflict.

Section 5. That this Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage, signing and publication as required by law.
