

Ordinance No. 01- 15

**AN ORDINANCE WAIVING SIDEWALK REQUIREMENTS
IN WILDWOOD ESTATES SUBDIVISION**

WHEREAS, the developer of Wildwood Estates Subdivision has requested a variance of sidewalk requirements as set forth in the Village of Chatham Subdivision Ordinance;

WHEREAS, Wildwood Estates Subdivision is a semi-rural subdivision, and a variance of sidewalks is appropriate;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The Village of Chatham hereby waives any requirement, as set forth in its subdivision ordinance, for the construction of sidewalks within Wildwood Estates Subdivision.


SECTION 2: This Ordinance is effective immediately.
