

ORDINANCE NO. 01 - 16

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING A BID
FOR CONSTRUCTION OF PLUMMER/GORDON INTERSECTION

WHEREAS; the Village of Chatham, through the State of Illinois, sought and obtained bids for the construction of a roadway and signals at the intersection of Plummer Boulevard and Gordon Drive; and

WHEREAS, the bids where opened on March 26th, 2001 at 9:00 a.m. and the lowest responsible bidder was identified; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Committee met to review said bids and is recommending the lowest bid from Freezen Inc. \$287,035.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois as follows:


Section 1: That the bid from Freezen Inc. is hereby accepted.


