A ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT  
WITH SANGAMON COUNTY CONCERNING GORDON/PLUMMER INTERSECTION


**WHEREAS**, the Village of Chatham, Illinois ("Village") and Sangamon County ("County"), are units of government of the State of Illinois; and

**WHEREAS**, intergovernmental agreements are expressly allowed by Article VII, Chapter 10 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 and by Section 5 of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 5 ILCS 220/5; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, BE IT ORDAINED that the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois as follows:

**SECTION 1.** the Intergovernmental Agreement attached hereto, marked as exhibit "A", is hereby approved and the appropriate officers are hereby authorized to execute said agreement.

**SECTION 2.** This Ordinance is effective upon passage and approval as provided by law.

## AGREEMENT

This Agreement entered into this 10 day of APRIL, A.D., 2001, by and between the COUNTY OF SANGAMON, ILLINOIS, hereinafter referred to as the COUNTY, and the VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS, hereinafter referred to as the VILLAGE, is to jointly improve the new intersection of Gordon Drive, CH 22, and Plummer Boulevard by installing traffic signals, providing left turn lanes for two (2) legs of the intersection and resurfacing of a portion of Gordon Drive, CH 22.

### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the County Board of Sangamon County, Illinois and the Village Board for the Village of Chatham, Illinois has determined the need to construct a new intersection on Gordon Drive, CH 22, as a result of the construction of a new high school for the Ball-Chatham School District; and,

WHEREAS, the construction of Plummer Boulevard will improve the east west traffic flow in the Village of Chatham between Illinois Route 4 and Gordon Drive, CH 22; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY is willing to pay a share of the traffic signal costs and roadway improvements on Gordon Drive, CH 22, based upon the projected traffic counts for the through north-south traffic on Gordon Drive, CH 22; and,

WHEREAS, the COUNTY is willing to pay for the cost of furnishing and installation of a 8 x 3 pre-cast box culvert under Plummer Boulevard located at Station 6066+63.00; and,

WHEREAS, the COUNTY will continue to have maintenance and jurisdiction of Gordon Drive, CH 22, and be responsible for 2/3 of the cost of maintenance of the traffic signals; and,

WHEREAS, the VILLAGE agrees to pay for the balance of the improvements not paid by the COUNTY; and,

WHEREAS, the VILLAGE is willing to accept maintenance and jurisdiction of Plummer Boulevard, be responsible for 1/3 of the cost of the maintenance of the traffic signals and pay 100% of the energy costs for the traffic signals.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. The COUNTY agrees to pay its share of the cost of the improvement known as County Section 97-00063-05-TL (See distribution of costs below).

2. The VILLAGE agrees to pay its share of the cost of the improvement known as Village Section 99-00023-00-PV and Section 99-00023-01-TL (See distribution of cost below).
3. The Division of Costs for the improvement of the Gordon Drive, CH 22, and Plummer Boulevard intersection shall be as follows:

4. The COUNTY agrees to retain its maintenance and jurisdiction of Gordon Drive upon completion of the improvements of said intersection.
5. The COUNTY agrees to accept 2/3 of the maintenance cost for the traffic signals installed at said intersection.
6. Upon completion of the intersection of Gordon Drive, CH 22, and Plummer Boulevard, the VILLAGE agrees to accept 1/3 of the maintenance cost for the traffic signals installed at said intersection.
7. The VILLAGE agrees to pay for 100% of the energy costs for the intersection.
8. The VILLAGE agrees to accept jurisdiction and maintenance responsibilities for the Plummer Boulevard leg of the intersection beginning at the west edge of pavement of the southbound through lane of Gordon Drive, CH 22.

This Agreement shall be binding upon and to the benefit of the parties hereto, their successors and assigns.
