FOR INTERNET WEB PAGE FOR THE VILLAGE


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF
CHATHAM, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The firm of Microchip Computer Solutions is hereby retained as a consulting firm for the Village of Chatham, to work on the Village's Web Page per the attached pay schedule on projects as determined by the Clerk of the Village.

SECTION 2: The work to be performed by Microchip Computer Solutions shall be performed pursuant to the terms and conditions contained in a "Agreement for Consultant Services". The Village President is authorized and directed to sign said agreement on behalf of the Village. The Clerk is authorized and directed to attest said agreement on behalf of the Village. The proper officers of the Village are authorized and directed to implement said Agreement on behalf of the Village.

SERVICE AGREEMENT FOR
WEB PAGE MAINTENANCE

- 1) This Service Agreement, dated as of May 22, 2001, is entered into, by the Village of Chatham ("the Village") and Microchip Computer Solutions ("MCS").
- 2) The Village agrees to pay MCS for the maintenance of the Village website according to the following fee schedule.

A) Add one link to an external site	\$5 per link
B) Add a simple page to any section	\$15 per Page
C) Add a page with graphics (3 or less) to any section	\$25 per Page
D) Update Any Page	\$10 per Page
E) Update Village Board Profiles (including pictures)	\$100 per Term
F) Add Text Document in electronic format	\$10 per Document
G) Digitizing a document not in electronic format	\$10 1 st Hour \$5 ea. Add. Hour
H) Website maintenance not listed above	\$30 per Hour
- 3) The Village Clerk shall be given notice in writing prior to work being performed with estimated costs. All work performed shall receive prior approval by the Village President.


