

Ordinance No. 01- 73

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AN ADVISORY BOARD KNOWN AS  
THE ENTERTAINMENT BOARD**

*BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE  
VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, AS FOLLOWS:*

**SECTION 1:** Chapter 33 of the Village of Chatham Code of Ordinances is amended by the addition of sections 33.60 through 33.63, to state as follows:

*ENTERTAINMENT ADVISORY BOARD*

**33.60 Establishment** There is hereby established an advisory board known as the Entertainment Board. The Entertainment Board shall have 10 members, all of which will be residents and registered voters of the Village of Chatham and shall otherwise qualify as officers of the Village. Board members shall be appointed by the Village President of Chatham, with the advice and consent of the Chatham Village Board. Initially, there will be a chairman and 3 members appointed with a term ending April 30, 2005; 3 members will be appointed with a term ending April 30, 2004, and 3 members will be appointed with a term ending April 30, 2003.. Thereafter, members shall have a term of 4 years or until a successor has been appointed and has qualified. Members may be removed from office in accordance with the Illinois Municipal Code.

**33.61 Meetings and Compensation**

Members of the Entertainment Board shall serve without compensation, except reimbursement of their out-of-pocket expenses in accordance with the reimbursement policies of the Village. The Board shall from time to time appoint from its members a

recording secretary. The Board shall meet at least once per calendar quarter; if a member is absent for three consecutive meetings, he or she shall be deemed to have abandoned the position. The Board shall conduct its meetings in accordance with Robert's Rules of Order, and shall be subject to the Illinois Open Meetings Law and the Illinois Freedom of Information Act. The Board shall provide minutes of its meetings to the Village Clerk. The Village President and a trustee of the Village Board appointed by the Village President shall be non-voting, ex officio members of the Entertainment Board.

### **33.62 Duties and Responsibilities**

The Entertainment Board shall have the duty of promoting, coordinating and scheduling musical and cultural entertainment in the Village Parks. Scheduling of such events shall be coordinated with the Chatham Recreation Commission, the Park Advisory Committee and the Director of Public Works. Where entertainers require payment, the Board may work with individuals, groups and companies, both for-profit and not-for-profit, to arrange for financial sponsorship of such entertainment. The Board may from time to time recommend general policies regarding the use of Village Parks for entertainment and cultural events for adoption by the corporate authorities, and shall be bound by such policies when they are adopted. The Board shall not itself have the power to establish or modify policies, enter into contracts, or spend public funds.


### **33.63 Staff Support; Reports to the Village Board**

The several department heads of the Village shall provide the Entertainment Board with whatever staff support the Board reasonably requests. From time to time, and at


least annually, the Entertainment Board shall render reports to the Village Board of its activities.

**SECTION 2:** This Ordinance is effective immediately. The clerk shall see to its inclusion in the next update of the Village Code of Ordinances.
