Ordinance No. 01- 83

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ELECTRIC RATE SCHEDULES AS SET FORTH IN THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM CODE OF ORDINANCES**

*BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:*

**SECTION 1:** Section 52.070 of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Chatham is amended to state as follows:

52.070 There shall be and there are hereby established rates and charges for the use and service of electric for light and power based upon electricity consumed as recorded by electric meters based upon the type of premises served as follows:

**A. STANDARD RESIDENTIAL SERVICE (ER01 & ER02)**

1) Rate

\$0.0770 / kwh

2) Facility Charge

\$3.00 per month

3) Fuel Adjustment

As per Section 52.013 of this Code of Ordinances

4) Application

All residential customers for single-phase service through a single meter for domestic use.

5) Nature of Service

Alternating current, 60 cycle, single phase, 120/240 nominal volts.

B. SENIOR CITIZEN RESIDENTIAL SERVICE (SR01 &SR02)

1) Rate

\$0.0617 / kwh

2) Facility Charge

\$3.00 per month

3) Fuel Adjustment

As per Section 52-013 of this Code of Ordinances

4) Application

Retired persons having attained the age of sixty-two (62) years of age where there is o one residing in the residence for which electric service is provided who is employed. Written application for this favorable rate must be made and the Director of Utilities may from time to time require reapplication.

5) Nature of Service

Alternating current, 60 cycle, single phase, 120/240 nominal volts.

C. PARKS SERVICE

1) Rate

\$0.0617 / kwh if metered, and/or \$5.00 per hour if un-metered

2) Facility Charge

\$7.00 per event

3) Fuel Adjustment - N/A

4) Application

Written application designating responsible person and contact number.

5) Nature of Service – N/A

D. GOVERNMENTAL (GV01 & DM01)

1) Rate

\$0.0617 / kwh

\$4.730 / per multiplier / per demand unit (demand will be the highest average kilowatt demand measured in any 15 minute period during the month)

2) Facility Charge

\$15.00 per month

3) Fuel Adjustment

As per Section 52-013 of this Code of Ordinances

4) Application

Governmental bodies duly established under the laws of the State of Illinois or the United States of America.

5) Nature of Service

Service will be delivered at one utilization voltage, point and meter. Any exception to the foregoing will be treated as supplemental facilities. Alternating current will be supplied at 60 cycle, 120/240 nominal volts,

single or three phase. When requested by the customer the utility will supply alternating current, 60 cycle, 120/208 nominal volts if available.

E. COMMERCIAL SERVICE WITHOUT DEMAND (ER03 &ER04)

1) Rate

\$0.1010 / kwh

2) Facility Charge

\$7.50 per month single phase

\$18.75 per month three phase

3) Fuel Adjustment

As per Section 52-013 of this Code of Ordinances

4) Application

Commercial, institutional, and non-residential or for three phase, residential, non-residential, institutional, and commercial use taken through a single meter at the utility standard secondary voltage without Demand metering.

5) Nature of Service

Service will be delivered at one utilization voltage, point and meter. Any exception to the foregoing will be treated as supplemental facilities. Alternating current will be supplied at 60 cycle, 120/240 nominal volts, single or three phase. When requested by the customer the utility will supply alternating current, 60 cycle, 120/208 nominal volts if available.

F. COMMERCIAL SERVICE W/DEMAND (EN01 EN03 & DM01 DM03)

1) Rate

\$0.0800 / kwh

\$4.730 / per multiplier (demand will be the highest average kilowatt demand measured in any 15 minute period during the month)

2) Facility Charge

\$7.50 per month single phase

\$18.75 per month three phase

3) Fuel Adjustment

As per Section 52-013 of this Code of Ordinances

4) Application

Commercial, institutional, and non-residential or for three phase, residential, non-residential, institutional, and commercial use taken through a single meter at the utility standard secondary voltage without Demand metering.

5) Nature of Service

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## G. INDUSTRIAL SERVICE (EN02 &DM02)

### 1) Rate

\$0.0700 / kwh

\$6.30 / per multiplier (demand will be the highest average kilowatt

demand measured in any 15 minute period during the month, minimum of

70kw. The Village may determine the actual demand either by

permanently installed instruments or by tests)

### 2) Facility Charge

\$15.00 per month single phase

\$37.50 per month three phase

### 3) Fuel Adjustment

As per Section 52-013 of this Code of Ordinances

### 4) Application

Commercial, industrial or manufacturing facilities.

### 5) Nature of Service

Service will be delivered at one utilization voltage, point and meter. Any

exception to the foregoing will be treated as supplemental facilities.

Alternating current will be supplied at 60 cycle, 120/240 nominal volts,

single or three phase. When requested by the customer the utility will

supply alternating current, 60 cycle, 120/208 nominal volts if available.

## H. SECURITY LIGHTING (SL01)



1) Rate

\$6.00 per month

**SECTION 2:** This Ordinance is effective upon its passage, approval and publication, and the rates set forth herein shall take effect on January 1, 2002. The Clerk shall publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form, and shall see to its inclusion in the next published update of the Village Code of Ordinances.


