This correspondence constitutes a proposal from Waste Management to provide services for the 2002 Chatham Fall Cleanup scheduled for September 23 –October 4, 2002.

Equipment Supplied:

Six (6) 20 yd3 Roll-off Containers

Schedule of Service:

Waste Management will deliver (6) Roll-off Containers on Monday, September 16 to the Chatham maintenance building.

Waste Management will provide an on-site roll-off driver to work with the crew daily to empty roll-offs as needed.

Charges for Service:

20 yd3 Container Delivery, Return, and Disposal (up to 7 tons) \$235

Please note that the 20 yd3 Containers have a maximum capacity of 7 ton. There will be a \$31 charge per ton over the maximum capacity of 7 ton.

To allow for safe transport on the roadways, all containers must be tarped. Therefore, the Roll-off Containers can only be filled level full to the top of the container. Any additional material will have to be removed and disposed of by the Village.

Please be aware that the following materials are unacceptable for disposal at the landfill, and therefore will **not be accepted** at the cleanup site: tires, appliances, yard waste, liquid waste (including used oil), lead-acid batteries, and special/hazardous wastes.

Mullin's Salvage of Mt. Olive, IL will provide a 45 foot trailer for appliances and metal. The trailer will be placed at the Chatham maintenance building. This service will be provided free of charge with a minimum of 4 tons of appliances received.
