

ORDINANCE 02 - 41

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 01-75
(AN ORDINANCE IN REFERENCE TO VILLAGE EMPLOYMENT)

WHEREAS, on November 27, 2001 the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham passed and approved an Ordinance to hire Robert Branham.

WHEREAS, the appropriate contract does not specify the terms of employment beyond the first year.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 1: of Ordinance 1-75 be amended as follows:

SECTION 1: Robert Branham Shall be employed as a Buildings and Grounds Technician on a full time basis to be paid an hourly wage of \$9.964 per the current Union Contract, distributed from the Electric, General and Water Funds. *Effective May 1, 2002 the salary shall be increased to \$10.514 per hour. Effective November 27, 2002 the salary shall be increased to \$11.020.*


SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and approval.
